Parish Councils: What Are Residents' Associations Spending Your Money On?

Have you seen the proposed new Parish Tax? It could cost Epsom households hundreds of pounds a year, with no limit on future increased spending.

Epsom & Ewell Borough Council, led by Residents' Associations, are proposing the creation of new Parish Councils. Initially, they would be responsible for... allotments. Yes, allotments. That's more of your money, on top of your existing Council Tax, just to manage allotments.
