That means making sure your voices are heard and your concerns are acted on – so our community gets the attention and resources it deserves.



## Helen's year in numbers...



- Successfully resolved over 7,000 issues for my constituents
- Submitted **262 questions** to get answers and hold the government to account
- Spoke 107 times on issues in Parliament



Rebuilding St Helier Hospital and protecting independent pharmacies have been top priorities for me.

This past year, I've been fighting for urgent

- I helped force a parliamentary debate on hospital delays
- I asked over **40 written questions** to the Department of Health
- I called for a Crumbling Hospitals
  Taskforce
- I abseiled down St Helier Hospital raising funds for the Epsom and St Helier Hospitals charity
- I spoke out **against the National**Insurance Contributions hike impacting pharmacies

Our pressure has paid off.

The government has committed £12 million for urgent repairs at St Helier Hospital.

And, the government has agreed to a new funding package, bringing total pharmacy support to £3.1 billion - a vital lifeline helping Horton Pharmacy keep









## Tackling the cost of living



#### **Backing our community**

I challenged the Government in Parliament and wrote to the Chancellor demanding urgent support for those hardest hit by the cost-of-living crisis.



#### Helping local families

Lib Dem pressure forced the government to extend free school meals to 500,000 more children - a key Lib Dem manifesto promise and a huge win for families in our area.



### **Supporting charities**

I recently held a Cost of Living Roundtable to develop practical solutions to support families facing rising costs. I've also raised their concerns directly with ministers, pushing for urgent action.

## **SAFER STREETS:**

Everyone deserves to feel safe in their community, and tackling anti-social behaviour is vital to making that happen. I've questioned the government on how they're supporting police, joined residents and local officers on community walkabouts, and pushed for clearer guidance to ensure people feel supported when reporting crime.

## TRAIN ACTION:



I'm working hard to get full train services restored. It's not good enough that we're still facing a reduced timetable. I've met with rail bosses to demand better services, proper investment and the rollout of long-overdue Arterio trains.

## SUPPORT EVERY CHILD:

The Special Educational Needs system is broken, and I've demanded concrete action to fix it. Working with fellow Lib Dem MPs, I'm holding Conservative-run Surrey County Council to account for their failure on this issue. I've raised individual cases, supported affected families, and I challenged the Education Minister directly.

This past year, Helen Maguire and the Lib Dems have led the charge to fix Thames Water and clean up our rivers. We are the only party with a serious plan to tackle the water crisis:





We're calling to scrap the weak water regulator Ofwat and replace it with a powerful Clean Water Authority.

We've also pushed for Thames Water to become a public benefit company that puts people and the environment before profit.

In 2024 alone, they dumped nearly 300,000 hours of sewage into the River Mole and Hogsmill – and I've challenged them directly over the damage.

Our action is starting to make a difference -Thames Water bosses are now facing **fines and blocked bonuses**. I won't stop speaking up for our rivers and local environment.

### CHAMPIONING A GREENER, MORE SUSTAINABLE

Epsom & Ewell's green spaces are central to our identity and well-being. I'm calling for more investment in flood prevention and renewable energy to drive a local, fair transition to Net Zero – and protect our environment for the future.





