


## Sports

Poor working conditions at St Helier Hospital are not only placing strain on hard working staff but also on Epsom Hospital, with patients and resources likely to be relocated there.


Despite Conservative promises to start rebuilding St Helier by 2030, Health Secretary Wes Streeting states this rebuild may be delayed until as late as 2038.

# **Road to Nowhere:**

Traffic delays are failing Epsom & Ewell residents

The completion of roadworks continue to inconvenience residents in **Epsom & Ewell.** 

Agencies must be held accountable for delays and poor communication, it is important residents are able to commute with ease.

For many months, filter lights were in place on Wells Road bridge with seemingly little to no work occurring on the road. There was no communication with

surrounding residents despite the bridge being the sole route in and out of the estate.

Helen Maguire MP wrote to

Network Rail demanding an

update on the work and clear communication on the situation to residents, as well as an update on when works will continue on Castle Road footbridge – a public right of way which has been closed for years. Shortly after this, work was quickly finished on the road, and the footbridge is set to be opened in November.

## Lib Dem Pressure Delivers Medicine for Pharmacies



Many local pharmacies have been facing increasing financial strain.

Under the Pharmacy First Scheme, pharmacies were promised £645 million, but only 12% has been disbursed—much of it tied to patient consultations rather than being provided as upfront cash. Community pharmacy staff have also faced a 40% real terms pay cut over the past decade, forcing some pharmacies to supply life-saving medications at a loss.

In response, Helen Maguire MP pressed Health Ministers with several letters demanding better support for independent pharmacies. Following Lib Dem pressure, the government has now agreed to a new funding package. This plan boosts total funding to £3.1 billion and addresses the issue of over-delivery on drug cost margins.

One local pharmacy which welcomes the news is Horton Pharmacy: "We're grateful to Helen and the Lib Dems for standing up for community pharmacies. While it still falls short of recommendations, this new funding package shows that sustained pressure can make a real difference. Many pharmacies like ours are still facing tough choices just to keep our doors open, but this gives us a bit of breathing space to keep serving our community."

## **Thames Water**

Residents Pay More — And Get Sewage in Return

Thames Water continue to let residents down. Despite rising bills, residents are not gaining much in return. In 2023, the Lib Dems obtained data from Thames Water revealing horrifying amounts of sewage was being pumped into the river. And yet customers are currently paying 31% more for Thames Water.

How can they get away with this? Your MP recognises it's not good enough.



## **Let's Get Epsom Back on Track**



Local people are concerned with the lack of frequency of trains. This has been an ongoing issue since the covid outbreak; the frequency of trains has not yet increased to pre-covid levels.

New Arterio trains with increased capacity are to be rolled out as the standard SWR

trains in Epsom & Ewell over the summer to ease overcrowding on trains.

However, only 5 of the 90 new £1 billion fleet of Arterio trains are currently in service. The majority have been stuck in storage due to a lack of trained drivers, with no clear date for the full roll-out. Alongside fellow Lib-Dem MPs, Helen Maguire has signed a letter to the Secretary of State demanding clarity on the matter. Your MP is also pushing for increased frequency of trains, especially at commuting times.
